A Portland-based engineering firm is expanding to the East Coast.

PAE Engineers, a sustainable engineering and consulting firm, has opened a New York City office, a news release from the firm said. The expansion will allow the firm to continue working on net-zero building projects and renovations across the city and along the East Coast.

"PAE's expansion to New York demonstrates our commitment to accelerating our impact on reversing the effects of climate change by bringing our extensive experience in building electrification and decarbonization to the East Coast," President and CEO of PAE Christian J. Agulles said in a news release. "This move allows us to better serve our East Coast clients while introducing our innovative building design solutions and employee-focused practices to the New York market."

The East Coast office will be led by Trevor Boz, principal and New York office director at PAE, and will start with 15 employees based in the office.

The expansion follows a landmark year in which the firm recorded its fourth consecutive year of record revenues with 536 projects completed throughout the U.S., according to the news release.

One project includes engineering a ground water heat pump at Portland International Airport's new main terminal. Another includes Seattle Aquarium's new Ocean Pavilion with an all-electric system to achieve a fossil fuel-free, carbon-neutral facility that integrates with the city's Waterfront development.

The company has also expanded its employee headcount by 16% to 400 total employees.

"New York City is always changing. Today, we have a tremendous opportunity to push its next evolution towards sustainability and decarbonization," Boz said in a news release. "With our office ribbon-cutting, we're thrilled to expand our high-performance building design principles and capabilities across the Empire State and East Coast."

PAE will continue to expand its footprint along the East Coast and across the country throughout 2025.
